MATCHBREAKER SCORES IMPRESSIVE WELLINGTON STAKES WIN

New Zealand Derby outlined for son of Makfi after Group Three success

Three-year-old Matchbreaker's (Makfi) progression from maiden win to a Wellington Stakes (Gr 3, 1600m) victory at just his third start came as no surprise to his trainer Fraser Auret who now has lofty ambitions for the gelding.

Matchbreaker, who started at \$4.50 on the back of a maiden at Otaki over 1400 metres on 9 November, appreciated the step up to 1600 metres yesterday when scoring by a short head over Trail Blazer (Roc De Cambes) (\$12) in the NZ\$70,000 Group Three race.

Divine Power (Power) (\$7) was another one and a quarter lengths away in third place.

Matchbreaker has been nominated for the Levin Classic (Gr 1, 1600m) and the New Zealand Derby (Gr 1, 2400m), with Group One plans outlined at least 12 months ago after the then two-year-old barrier trialed against subsequent Group Two winner Hard Merchandize (Burgundy).

"I remember his first trial as a two-year-old. Hard Merchandize won, he was second and Waldorf was third but we've just nursed him along. He has always had the goods," Auret said.

<< *Continued from page 1* Yesterday, Matchbreaker was ridden to victory by Chris Johnson, who initially settled outside the early leader Lady Rossa (Bernardini) before taking the front a long way from home.

"He went pretty keen and it might take some work to get him to go further but (rider) Chris (Johnson) doesn't panic and it was a great ride," Auret said.

"It helps to have a Group Three in the bank (and) he's a beautiful horse, that's for sure."

Passed in at the New Zealand Bloodstock Premier Yearling Sale in 2016 (reserve NZ\$45,000) by vendor Highden Park, Matchbreaker (3 g Makfi - Pineau by Carnegie) has earned NZ\$48,875 from his three career starts.

Matchbreaker, the fifth foal of winning mare Pineau (Carnegie), is a half-brother to three other foals to race with two of them winning including Listed winner Dancer's Tale (Tale Of The Cat) and Travimyfriend (Tavistock).

Bred by Haunui Farm, Pineau is a half-sister to Doomben Cup (Gr 1, 2000m) runner-up Octapussy (Octagonal), Group Two-placed Irion (Danroad) and three-time stakes producer Our Riesling (Last Tycoon). Our Riesling, who is now owned by China Horse Club, is the dam of Group Three winner Valpolicella (Red Ransom) and second dam of Group Two winner Vavasour (Redoute's Choice), MRC Autumn Classic (Gr 2, 1800m) winner Vilanova (Commands) and last Saturday's WATC Jungle Mist Classic (Listed, 1200m) winner Celebrity Dream (Thorn Park).

Octapussy, meanwhile, is the dam of Group Two winner Pussy Willow (O'Reilly), her Listed-winning sister Pussy O'Reilly and the late VRC Poseidon Stakes (Listed, 1400m) winner Inside Agent (Stravinsky), who was trained by Nigel Blackiston at Flemington.

Pineau has a two-year-old sister to Matchbreaker and after failing to get in foal to Sacred Falls (O'Reilly) in 2015 was due to foal to Ocean Park (Thorn Park) this year.

Matchbreaker is the 21st stakes winner for the now Japan-based stallion Makfi (Dubawi), who shuttled to Westbury Stud for six seasons before being sold after covering mares in New Zealand in 2016. Makfi is also the sire of three-time Group One winner Bonneval, Australian Oaks (Gr 1, 2400m) winner Sofia Rosa and Manawatu Sires' Produce Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) winner Marky Mark.

Chambord scores long-awaited stakes win with Otaki victory

The legacy of the late champion Cambridge Stud-based stallion Zabeel (Sir Tristram) was again apparent yesterday when his lightly raced son Chambord won the Levin Stakes (Listed, 1200m) at Otaki after overcoming career-threatening injuries.

The seven-year-old gelding, who is trained by Stephen Autridge and Jamie Richards for Te Akau Racing, was having his second start back from a lengthy spell when he was able to overhaul dual Group One winner Start Wondering (Eighth Wonder) by a long neck yesterday.

The Steve Gulliver-trained Shadow Fox (Keeninsky) was another length away in third.

<< *Continued from page 2* The Sir Patrick and Lady Hogan-bred Chambord, who was runner-up in the 2013 New Zealand 2,000 Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) at Riccarton, became Zabeel's 165th individual stakes winner as a sire.

The victory of Chambord came in the same week as Sir Patrick announced he had sold Cambridge Stud to Auckland-based breeders Brendan and Jo Lindsay after more than 40 years under his ownership.

Richards revealed Chambord's career was halted due to a cannon bone injury in 2014 and had raced just eight times since before yesterday's breakthrough success.

"He broke down in his final gallop before the Coupland's Mile three years ago, he shattered his cannon bone and we got him back from that," Richards said.

"That wasn't his only major injury either. He's had stress fractures high up in his back and lots of other bits and pieces, but he's as sound now as he's ever been.

"He's been a great horse for the stable and the owners have never moaned with all the things that have gone wrong."

Chambord was ridden by Cameron Lammas, who settled the gelding on the fence three pairs back before getting clear running in the straight.

"We got a lovely run on the fence and when we came out I knew the second horse had a lot more weight so I bided my time a bit and then got him," Lammas said.

Richards said Chambord could be aimed at the Railway Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) on New Year's Day, a race yesterday's runner-up Start Wondering won this year, but would monitor the gelding's condition before locking in a plan.

"We're always hoping he pulls up fine and he's nominated for the Railway and the Telegraph, but whether they may be a bit sharp for him we're not sure," he said.

"There's a Listed race over 1400 metres at Te Rapa in a couple of weeks and that could lead up to the Rich Hill Mile if we think he can stretch out to 1600 metres."

An NZ\$200,000 purchased by Te Akau Racing's David Ellis from the Cambridge Stud draft at the 2012 New Zealand Bloodstock Premier Yearling Sale, Chambord (7 g Zabeel - Miss Montjeu by Montjeu) has won four of his 21 starts with eight placings for prize money of NZ\$209,175.

Chambord is a son of the winning mare Miss Montjeu (Montjeu), who is a half-sister to Hong Kong Mile (Gr 1, 1600m) winner The Duke (Danehill) and a half-sister to Moorea (Zabeel), the dam of Gilgai Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m) winner and Coolmore Stud Stakes (registered as Ascot Vale Stakes) (Gr 1, 1200m) runner-up Keen Array (Bel Esprit). Another half-sister, the placed mare Coogee Coozifa (Danzero), is also the dam of the stakes-placed Oink (Sebring), who is trained by Kelly Schweida in Queensland.

Chambord's third dam Make Plans (Go Marching) is the dam of Group Two-winning stallion Monde Bleu (Last Tycoon), King's Stand Stakes (Gr 1, 5f) winner Sayf El Arab (Drone) and fellow European Listed winner Bestplan (Try My Best).

Miss Montjeu has an unraced three-year-old filly called Mongolian Diamond, who is trained by Donna Logan and Chris Gibbs, and a yearling colt by Savabeel (Zabeel), making him a three-quarter brother to Chambord.

The Savabeel colt will be offered by Cambridge Stud as **Lot 392** in book one of the NZB Karaka Yearling Sale Series next year. Miss Montjeu was due to foal to resident stallion Power (Oasis Dream) this year.

Zabeel, who died in September 2015 after being pensioned in 2013, has sired 165 stakes winners including 46 at Group One level. They include champions Octagonal and Might And Power.

First for The Factor

The Newgate Farm-based shuttler The Factor (War Front) sired his first winner in Australia courtesy of The Unknown Factor's (2 g ex Mixed Up Miss by Forest Glow) winning debut in a maiden two-year-old plate over 1000 metres at Canberra yesterday. The Gratz Vella-trained two-year-old stayed on powerfully to beat Lu's In Charge (Charge Forward) by just over a length with another half a length back to Delchuzny (Delago Deluxe) in third. The Factor is the sire of eight stakes winners, including Grade One winner Noted And Quoted. The sire stands at Newgate Farm and commands a fee of \$11,000 (inc GST).

Schofield keeps faith in Japonisme

Group One-winning sprinter Japonisme (Choisir) has failed to live up to expectations since his Coolmore Stud Stakes (registered as Ascot Vale Stakes) (Gr 1, 1200m) success but jockey Glyn Schofield is hopeful the gelding can return to form at Rosehill today. The Chris Waller-trained gelding has won a Warwick Farm barrier trial since his last start at Hawkesbury on 9 November and runs in today's Festival Stakes (Gr 3, 1500m). "He jumped and led under no pressure and was entitled to win,"

Schofield said. "I'm glad that he won the trial. A little bit of rain would help him enormously and if he comes back to anywhere near his old form he just wins."

Australian debut for Mister Sea Wolf

Joining Japonisme in the Festival Stakes will be his new stablemate Mister Sea Wolf (Amadeus Wolf) who will be making his Australian debut in the since being transferred from Ireland. The gelding has won six times, twice for trainer Michael Dods and a further four times for handler Ger Lyons, who the was transferred to after Peter Tighe's Magic Bloodstock Racing bought into the six-year-old. "I always like to see a run or two with these horses but he's settled in well and his trial was good," Waller said on his online stable update. "He's got a bit of class about him and his form in Ireland is actually very good."

Vet inspection for Moher

The James Cummings-trained Moher (Lonhro) will be examined by Racing NSW veterinarians when he arrives at Rosehill today before he takes his place in the Festival Stakes after the stable reported the horse was kicked by one of his stablemates yesterday. Darren Beadman, stable representative for Godolphin trainer James Cummings, told stewards Moher was kicked in his off-side hock on Friday morning by a stablemate and had sustained a minor abrasion. "The clearance advises that Moher had some minor localised swelling to the hock but no pain on palpation and was sound at the trot," Racing NSW stewards said. "Moher will be examined by Racing NSW Veterinarians when it arrives on course at Rosehill Gardens tomorrow."

Redouble going for three straight

Trainer Bjorn Baker will be hoping Redouble (Redoute's Choice) can bring up a hat-trick of victories at Rosehill when he takes his chance

in the Boxing Day At Royal Randwick Handicap (1500m) today. The four-year-old gelding will be looking to follow up his recent victories at the track and will be stepping up to 1500 metres for the first time since March. "There's no form like winning form and it was a big win last time so I think we go in with a fair bit of confidence," Baker said. "He's a horse that's shown ability so it's nice to see him delivering."

Gamblestown continues return from retirement

Trainer Joe Pride will be hoping the punt to bring Gamblestown (Darci Brahma) back from retirement will finally pay off when the gelding lines up in the ATC Cup (Listed, 2000m) at Rosehill today. Leg issues appeared to have ended the seven-year-old's racing life but after more than a year off. He made his comeback in September and has recorded two minor placings and heads in today's having finished sixth in the Goulburn Cup (1600m) last weekend. "We sent him to the paddock as a retired horse and after six months we started to get ideas that maybe he could come back," Pride said. "If you take the horse on face value of his last couple of runs you'd say he looks like he's looking for 2000."

Gelding the key to Junglized

Junglized (Snitzel) will look to add a Rosehill victory to his recent wins at Hawkesbury and Canterbury when he takes his chance in a Benchmark 75 (1200m) at Rosehill today. The three-year-old gelding was trainer Brad Widdup's first runner and winner at Canberra in May shortly after he started training out of Platinum Park following a decade on Godolphin's staff. In three starts since being gelded, Junglized has registered a second and back-to-back wins at Hawkesbury and Canterbury over 1100 metres. "The gelding has helped him relax and race a lot better. He's just racing a lot more genuinely," Widdup said.

McEvoy set to run juveniles at Sandown

Trainer Tony McEvoy will unleash talented two-year-old's Sanctimonious (Foxwedge) and Logan River (Snitzel) in the Cameron Thurley's Bucks Day Plate (1000m) at Sandown Hillside today. The pair both impressed when winning their 800 metre jump out at Canterbury on Monday. "They've both come through their trials on Monday (Cranbourne) in really good order and they are ready to make their debuts tomorrow," stable representative Michael Shepherdson told Racing.com. "Logan River, he was very dominant in his trial. He's a big, mature two-year-old who's readymade and we really like him. Sanctimonious didn't do anything wrong in his trial. He had the blinkers on just to help him through the early part of the trial and he was very strong late."

Second time lucky for Moroney pair

After wet weather meant last week's Kilmore Cup day was cancelled, trainer Mike Moroney will now run War Legend (Rip Van Winkle) in the Ladbrokes Handicap (1800m) while Lord Barrington (Darci Brahma) is scheduled to run in the Schweppes Handicap (1300m) at Sandown Hillside today instead. Moroney said both horses handle rain-affected ground. "We just wanted rain for him," Moroney said of War Legend. "So we hope that they run the races because they are two horses who handle wet ground. We had them both in at Kilmore and the races were called off. The ground would have been ideal if they had run the races at Kilmore. A bit of rain would bring both of them right into being really good chances."

Wet track test for Flash Cash

Trainer Matt Laurie will be hoping Flash Cash (Pluck) can show him that he warrants a trip to the Magic Millions race day in January when he lines up in the Chandler Macleod Handicap (1300m) at Sandown Hillside today. "He's got a fair bit to do for me to go down that path," Laurie said. "You've got to keep them nominated for those things because you never can tell sometimes. It's a matter of what's the track like and what you can take out of it, but if he performs below par can you attribute that to the surface. That will be the query."

McGillivray to ride Siegfried

Siegfried (Jet Spur) is set to resume in today's George Moore Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m) at Doomben despite the fact trainer Toby Edmonds believes the wet surface will play against the seven-year-old. Siegfried, who raced consistently during the autumn in Queensland, will be ridden by Matt McGillivray today with Edmonds' usual go-to jockeys Jeff Lloyd and Robbie Fradd riding overseas this weekend. "(Siegfried) ran second in the Prime Minister's Cup and third in a Weetwood Handicap during the winter so he has shown this is about his class," Edmonds said.

Butterworth puts faith in Byrne

Trainer Paul Butterworth was concerned he may have been left without a jockey for his Group One winner Capital Gain (Ad Valorem), who has his first start as a three-year-old at Doomben today. The winner of the J J Atkins Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m) in June, Capital Gain will resume in the Winning Rupert Plate (1200m) today with Jim Byrne taking the ride after overcoming an ankle injury. "Jim seems to know exactly how to ride Capital Gain. There were a few others chasing the ride if Jim was hurt but it is good to have him," Butterworth said.

Doomben set to go ahead

Stewards inspected a rain-soaked Doomben racecourse late yesterday, with the George Moore Stakes meeting given the all-clear to proceed today. The Ipswich meeting yesterday was abandoned after the track was soaked by 80 millimetres of rain in the past three days. Doomben course manager Jim Roberts said the track had received 65 millimetres, mostly in a huge storm on Wednesday. "The track can come back quickly and a soft surface on Saturday is not out of the realms. But the weather will obviously play a part," Roberts said. Chief steward Allan Reardon said there was no danger to the meeting unless heavy rain returned.

Newmarket aim for Merchant Navy

Coolmore Stud Stakes (registered as Ascot Vale Stakes) (Gr 1, 1200m) winner Merchant

Navy (Fastnet Rock) will be aimed at another Group One victory at Flemington in the autumn, with the Newmarket Handicap (Gr 1, 1200m) his primary aim. Trainer Aaron Purcell and his assistant David Eustace have inspected Merchant Navy and plan to bring him back into work soon. "At this stage, the plan is for him to target the Newmarket Handicap. "Aaron and David saw him earlier in the week and were delighted with how he has developed during his break," Coolmore Australia racing manager Sebastian Hutch told ANZ Bloodstock News. "He looks to have a very exciting autumn ahead of him."

Marshall appeals ban

Apprentice jockey Taylor Marshall will appeal the decision and the severity of a 26-meeting suspension for careless riding which saw fellow rider Arron Lynch fall and break a leg in an incident during a race at Yarra Valley on 28 October. Marshall will front the Racing Appeals and Disciplinary Board (RAD) on Monday. Fellow rider Jake Duffy has also appealed a \$1,000 fine after pleading guilty to a charge of failing to ride out Arthur Porrit (Bachelor Duke) in the final four strides when fourth at Seymour on 16 November.

Sadler charged with improper conduct

Trainer John Sadler faces a charge of improper conduct over the scratching of Observational (Galileo) from a race at Sandown. Racing Victoria stewards issued the charge against Sadler for his alleged conduct before and after stewards ordered Observational's scratching from the Eclipse Stakes (Gr 3, 1800m) at

Sandown on 18 November. Observational was withdrawn after an out-of-competition test the previous day returned a TC02 level of 36.4 mmol per litre of plasma with stewards concerned he may have been administered an alkalisng agent within one clear day of the race. Stewards allege comments made by Sadler to chairman of stewards Terry Bailey in telephone calls on the morning of the race and in person to Bailey and deputy chairman Robert Cram at Sandown on the day of the race constituted improper conduct.

Francis re-elected as SAJC chair

Bodelle Francis will chair the South Australian Jockey Club for another term after being re-elected unopposed on Thursday night at the organisation's annual general meeting. Francis has been re-elected for another 12 months, with Bob Holton and Tony Newman re-elected unopposed as deputy chairman and deputy vice-chairman respectively. Adam Glenn and Paul Kristoris were also confirmed as SAJC board members at the meeting.

New Zealand

21 for Makfi

Former shuttler Makfi (Dubawi) sired his 21st stakes winner after Matchbreaker's (3 g ex Pineau by Carnegie) victory in the Wellington Stakes (Gr 3, 1600m) at Otaki yesterday. Matchbreaker appreciated the step up to 1600 metres yesterday when scoring by a short head over Trail Blazer (Roc De Cambes) in the NZ\$70,000 Group Three race. Divine Power (Power) was another one and a quarter lengths away in third place. Makfi, who shuttled to Westbury Stud for six seasons, now stands in Japan after Qatar Bloodstock sold the sire to Japan Bloodhorse Breeders' Association last year.

165 for Zabeel

The Stephen Autridge and Jamie Richards-trained Chambord (7 g ex Miss Montjeu by Montjeu) ran out a comfortable winner of the Levin Stakes (Listed, 1200m) at Otaki yesterday and in the process provided the late Cambridge Stud-based sire Zabeel (Sir Tristram) with his 165th stakes winner. The seven-year-old

gelding put in a taking performance to get the better of Group One winner Start Wondering (Eighth Wonder) by three quarters of a length with another length back to Shadow Fox (Keeninsky) in third. Champion sire Zabeel died in 2015, aged 29.

High hopes for Snow Secret

Trainer Shaune Ritchie has said he will be disappointed if Snow Secret (Sakhee's Secret) does not go close in today's Wanganui Cup (Listed, 2040m). The mare comes into the race having run second in the Rotorua Challenge Plate (Listed, 1950m) in October, while she was most recently seen finishing third in the Feilding Gold Cup (Listed, 2100m) earlier in the month. "It looks her race, she's been competitive in better fields than this," Ritchie said. "It's a lead-up to the Waikato Cup, but we'll be trying to win this one first, that's for sure. She's been Group Three placed and a multiple stakes placegetter and we want that elusive stakes win for her."

Stakes races on cards for Ja Ja Binks

Lightly-raced five-year-old mare Ja Ja Binks (Falkirk) will resume in the Benchmark 85 (1100m) at Ellerslie today and co-trainers David and Emma-Lee Browne have said they will be looking to land a stakes race with the mare this preparation. Ja Ja Binks came close to winning black-type last season, finishing second in the Flying Handicap (Listed, 1400m). "We're definitely chasing black-type with her this preparation but we'll just get through this weekend and see where we're at with her, see how she's coming up," Emma-Lee Browne said. "She's probably going to need the run on Saturday. She's had a couple of trials but we put her out for a spell after her trial at Te Teko in early August because she doesn't handle heavy tracks and doesn't really like the spring."

Asia

Moore satisfied with Helene Paragon

Trainer John Moore has said he is satisfied with the condition of Helene Paragon (Polan) ahead of his tilt in the Hong Kong Mile (Gr 1, 1600m) at Sha Tin 10 December

despite the gelding's muted trial yesterday. The dual Group One winner finished nine and a half lengths last of nine in trial one over 1200 metres at Sha Tin yesterday, but Moore seemed unperturbed by the display. "I wouldn't read too much into Helene Paragon's trial," the trainer said. "He's had an eye issue, and for that reason he wore a hood and a pacifier and I put him in a wide gate so he didn't get any sand kicked in his eye."

Clipperton looks forward to House Of Fun

With Joao Moreira unavailable to ride the John Size-trained House Of Fun (Starcraft), jockey Sam Clipperton will be hoping to take full advantage when he partners the gelding for the first time in the Class Two Nathan Handicap (1200m) at Sha Tin on Sunday. The five-year-old will be looking to improve on his last start second in the Chevalier Lifts & Escalator Handicap (1000m) when he lines up on Sunday. "I think he probably should have won last weekend, but it has worked out well otherwise - he probably wouldn't have lined up on Sunday if he had won, that's for sure," said Clipperton. "He's obviously going very well, so if he gets a reasonable run from the awkward barrier, he should be in the finish."

International

Daughters of Dark Angel and Invincible Spirit make 600,000gns

At the time of going to press, a filly by Dark Angel (Acclamation) and filly by Invincible Spirit (Green Desert) were topping the December Foal Sale after being purchased for 600,000 guineas by Capital Bloodstock and Charlie Gordon-Watson respectively. Catalogued as **Lot 927**, the Dark Angel filly is out of Listed-winning and Group Three-placed Sir Percy (Mark Of Esteem) mare Indigo Lady and was purchased for the Ringford Stud draft. "We are overwhelmed really," said Derek Veitch of Ringfort Stud. "It is wonderful. I own Indigo Lady with Paul Hancock. He hasn't been well recently - he had to have his appendix out - but is watching online. I bought into the mare after she had picked up black-type in France. Then she won a Listed race for us."

Gordon Watson fights off fierce competition

Later on in the day, Charlie Gordon-Watson, standing with Simon Marsh, fought off competition from Chris Richardson to take home the daughter of Invincible Spirit for 600,000 guineas from the Bryanstown House Stud draft. Catalogued as **Lot 965** this filly is out of the King's Best (Kingmambo) mare Liscune, making the filly a sister to Listed winner Ektihaam and Group Three winner Music Box. Further back this is the same family as Group Three winners Royal Lorna (Val de L'Orne) and Lycitus (Lycius).

Golden Horn colt makes 325,000gns

A colt from the first crop of Derby (Gr 1, 1m4f) winner Golden Horn (Cape Cross), who stands at Darley's Dalham Hall, realised 325,000 guineas on the third day of the Tattersalls December Foal Sale yesterday after Anthony Stroud signed for the colt on behalf of Godolphin. Catalogued as **Lot 925**, the foal's

Nick Pocock of Stringston Farm expressed his delight at the result: "The Gleneagles filly was a May foal and it's a credit to her that she was able to cope with everything," said Pocock. "To be honest, we probably asked more of her as a May foal than we should have done, but she's come up here and shown well and done everything that was asked of her." Sitara has an Australia (Galileo) yearling colt that made 525,000 guineas at the Tattersalls October Yearling Sale and is with Aidan O'Brien, and is back in foal to Swettenham Stud shuttler Tornado (High Chaparral).

No certainty delivered by the Government's token gesture

The Hunter's Thoroughbred Breeding Industry notes the Government's prohibition of open cut mining on the Drayton South site but this alone does not provide the Hunter's breeding industry with the certainty it has been calling on for over six years now.

Contrary to the Premier's commitment to provide certainty to our industry, today's announcement perpetuates the land use conflict, uncertainty, instability and unnecessary community division between mining and thoroughbred breeding in the Hunter Valley that we have been calling on them to address.

"It is enormously frustrating that eight months after the second PAC rejection of

mining on the Drayton South site all the Government can do is announce renewal of the Exploration Licence (EL), with a token gesture to prohibit open cut mining on the site - an outcome that was hard fought for, and already won by our industry, after six long years of planning process and 4 PACs." Dr Cameron Collins, President of the Hunter Thoroughbred Breeders Association said.

We called on the NSW Government not to renew the Drayton South exploration licence, which expired on 1 April 2016. A decision not to renew it would have provided certainty to all players in the Hunter and sent a positive signal to our industry and avoided protracted community conflict. The Government today decided to do the contrary.

"The message the NSW Government has sent today to our industry, employees and investors is that Australia's Premier Thoroughbred Breeding Industry is not valued, not protected and not wanted in the Hunter Valley." Dr Collins said

"How many more PACs and mining applications will it take for the NSW Government to understand that mining and thoroughbred breeding are incompatible land uses in close proximity. And that the impacts of underground mining are potentially as threatening to our industry as open cut coal mining?"

"The Government had an opportunity to show vision and leadership and deliver on its election promises and Government policies to provide us with certainty and protect our industry and the water systems we rely on. Today's decision to renew the Drayton South EL delivers the opposite and continues investment uncertainty, endless planning processes and unnecessary community conflict. This is an untenable and unacceptable situation." Dr Collins said.

It's been quite a week for jockeys on a hot streak as Steve reports:

The riding achievements of Jamie Kah and Robbie Fradd, this week, deserve greater fanfare than they've been accorded. I'm sure they would have had their 'bags' come in Sydney or Melbourne.

Kah, of course, combined with trainer Ryan Balfour in a career-best five winners at Morphettville last Saturday while Fradd booted home six winners (including one dead-heat) for five different stables at the Gold Coast on Wednesday.

Kah, for good measure, has ridden five winners from seven rides since last Saturday including a treble at Gawler on Wednesday; has a full book in Adelaide this Saturday and has a clear lead in both the state-wide and metropolitan jockeys' premierships, both of which she won by a space last season.

She rode 129 winners across the state in South Australia last season which was just one shy of double the next best tally recorded by Matthew Poon who's now riding in Hong Kong.

That tally gave her the record for the most wins by a female jockey in an Australian season. Her 129 winners in a season surpassed the previous record of 111 held jointly by Victoria's Linda Meech and South Australia's Clare Lindop.

In 2013, the now 21 year-old, became the first apprentice to claim the Adelaide Jockeys Premiership in almost 20 years. She also collected the first of her three John Letts Medals for excellence in riding.

Her strike rate is sound and she showed she could handle greater intensity with her winning rides on Dollar For Dollar (High Chaparral) in Melbourne through the spring carnival.

"Jamie is an amazing rider, she gets that little bit more from horses that other jockeys just can't seem to find," Balfour said last week.

She's managed by astute racing analyst Nick Pinkerton who is, understandably but also justifiably, keen to sing her praises. "She has a great affinity with horses and she has a tremendous temperament and will to win," he said.

She is, in my opinion, among the best riders - male or female - in the country and I'm sure would succeed in Sydney and Melbourne with the right support. Just as, I'm sure, would Willie Pike if he left Western Australia which he dominates every bit as much as Kah does in South Australia.

Robbie Fradd is enjoying a great season in Queensland where he sits one win behind fellow South African and fellow veteran Jeff Loyd in the metropolitan jockeys' premierships. State-wide he's third behind Loyd and yet another veteran Jim Byrne.

Fradd, who turns 53 on Monday, was champion jockey in no less a competitive jurisdiction than Hong Kong in 2000/2001. Loyd, incidentally, is 56 and Byrne is 46.

All of the above underlines the single most extraordinary aspect of horse racing. It is the only legitimate and physically demanding sport where the competitors are on a level played field irrespective of age or gender.

It also highlights a basic tenet of the punt - the more winners a jockey rides on a day then

the more he is likely to ride. If anyone tells you otherwise, then disregard each and every other opinion they ever proffer on the turf, or any other subject for that matter.

We see it time and time again with Joao Moreira obviously something of a poster boy for the theory in recent years - with a record-equaling most wins in a Hong Kong race day (six on 1 March, 2015); eight wins from eight rides at Kranji (6 September, 2013); and eight wins in a day at Cidade Jardim (March, 2006).

Craig Newitt rode four winners at Hobart on November 18, and followed up with another quartet at Launceston on Wednesday.

And it's been ever thus. Miller's Guide lists 53 jockeys believed to have ridden the card. It lists around 200 jockeys to have ridden at least five in a day.

Willie Shoemaker rode six winners in a day, in the United States, on no fewer than six occasions. Darren Beadman rode five in a day on nine occasions; Damien Oliver's done it eight times. And who could forget Frankie Dettori's 'magnificent seven' when he rode the card at Ascot on 28 September, 1996.

Ryan Moore rode six winners last Saturday in Tokyo where Christophe Lemaire rode eight winners, at the one meeting, earlier in November. And therein lies another lesson for punters. Promote any horse ridden by a visiting jockey in Japan. On that basis, you'd of course backed Cheval Grand (Heart's Cry), at the juicy odds, with Hugh Bowman aboard last weekend in the Japan Cup (Gr 1, 2400m).

Confidence is everything in sport and perhaps even more so in racing where the split second decisions are as 'split' at you can get. There's virtually no chance of retrieving the ball if you fumble it first time.

Lot 646 Kodiak - Gold Again colt

On a day beset by increasingly heavy snow showers, the second session of the Tattersalls December Foal Sale was topped by a son of Kodiak (Danehill) who went the way of Sun Stud for 210,000 guineas.

It was another day of strong trade, with 216 lots changing hands for turnover of 9,258,500 guineas for a ten per cent year-on-year gain, an average of 42,865 guineas for a seven per cent increase and a median of 33,500 guineas - up from 30,000 guineas.

The session-topping son of Tally-Ho Stud's record-breaking sire Kodiak was the first foal this week to break the 200,000 guineas barrier, as the Australian-based Sun Stud team saw off Hubert Honore for the Meadowlands Stud-consigned colt, who was catalogued as **Lot 646**.

"He's really well bred, obviously Kodiak is a high-class stallion and he's a full-relation to

a stakes winner," said the stud's bloodstock adviser David O'Callaghan of the brother to Grade Three winner Spirit Of Xian.

"He's a lovely balanced, attractive colt and will be raced by Sun Bloodstock. It would have been a lot of money for a pinhook, and it was a lot of money to race too, but when you're buying to race you can afford to spend a little more. If he can run he won't look expensive."

Sun Stud have been active as sellers as well as buyers this week, having bred the Kodiak half-sister to Barney Roy (Excelebration) who topped Monday's December Yearling Sale at 400,000 guineas.

The transaction also provided Meadowlands' Brian Kennedy, who bred the colt out of the Touch Gold (Deputy Minister) mare Gold Again, with his best ever result at Tattersalls.

"I bought the mare here as a maiden at the December Sale in 2009 for 6,200 guineas,"

explained Kennedy. "I liked her because of the Miswaki in her pedigree. Her second covering was by Kodiak and she produced Spirit Of Xian. I like working with Tally-Ho and we have been lucky together. I always sell my stock as foals, then I can concentrate on the mares in the spring."

Kodiak, who has supplied a staggering 54 two-year-old winners in Europe in 2017, has had seven lots sell this week for an aggregate of 702,000 guineas and an average of 100,285 guineas for foals bred at a covering fee of €45,000.

New blood for Cheveley

Cheveley Park Stud, which has been a major force at a variety of sales throughout 2017, made a noteworthy addition during Thursday's session when securing an Acclamation (Royal Applause) filly from Trickle-down Stud for 200,000 guineas.

Catalogued as **Lot 664**, the January foal is out of the Whipper mare Party Whip (Miesque's Son), meaning she is closely related to the Group Three winner Nations Alexander (Dark Angel).

"We're looking to invest in different families," said Cheveley Park's managing director Chris Richardson. "This was a beautiful filly, very athletic, and the half-sister is a good filly."

"From the minute she walked off the lorry she was a queen," said consignor Paul Thorman, whose Trickle-down Stud was leading vendor by aggregate on Thursday.

"Both Sarah [Thorman] and I loved her, which is a rare thing, but you'd have to be blind not to see that she's a beauty. We had 13 vets and in 40 years of selling I've never had 13 vets on one horse."

Just two lots later Trickle-down landed another blow when Yeomanstown Stud went to 125,000 guineas for the Gutaifan (Dark Angel) colt out of the Listed-winning Cape Factor (Oratorio), who was catalogued as **Lot 666**.

"He was the best Gutaifan I've seen," said Thorman. "He was an outstanding physical with an outstanding temperament. I've looked at all the Gutaifans at Goffs last week and I've looked at most of the ones here, and none have come close to him."

"Dark Angel's third cousin could sell well at the moment, but the Gutaifans are some pretty impressive foals."

Absolutely Acclamation

The second Acclamation foal to bring a six-figure sum came late in the session when trainer Joe Tuite struck at 130,000 guineas for a brother to the Group Three winner Absolutely So offered by Castledillon Stud, who was catalogued as **Lot 774**.

"He'll go back to a stud in Ireland," said Tuite. "An owner of mine wanted a foal, he picked this one out and asked me to come and get him. I'm not sure what the longer-term plan with him will be just yet."

By the close of trade on day two, four lots by Rathbarry Stud's Acclamation had sold for 416,000 guineas and an average of 104,000 guineas.

Drawing Breath

The first lot to hit the six-figure mark was the Bated Breath (Dansili) colt out of Lifting Me Higher, who went the way of Frannie Woods of Abbeylands Farm for 150,000 guineas.

Catalogued as **Lot 511**, the colt was bred by the Pococks and offered by the family's Stringston Farm, and is out of the daughter of Sea The Stars (Cape Cross), who was bought carrying the Bated Breath colt for 42,000 guineas by Rob Speers at last year's December Sale.

"He's from a great farm that we've had some luck buying from before," said Woods, alluding to the Australia half-brother to Rekindling who he pinhooked for 165,000 guineas and sold on to MV Magnier, Mayfair Speculators and Peter and Ross Doyle for 525,000 guineas at Book One back in October.

"He was a pretty obvious horse, by a very good sire and that was his value. I'm glad to have him because I've loved him from the minute I saw him so I was always going to make a play for him. He'll be back here next October all being well."

A second lot fetched 150,000 guineas later in the session, with Amanda Skiffington signing the docket for a colt from the first crop of Gleneagles offered by Glashare House Stud, who was catalogued as **Lot 594**.

Selwood Exceed

Yeomanstown Stud, which picked up Wednesday's session-topping Farhh (Pivotal) colt at 160,000 guineas, was back in action 24 hours when snapping up a son of Darley's stalwart shuttler Exceed And Excel (Danehill)

for 130,000 guineas. The colt, who was catalogued as **Lot 578**, is out of Red Intrigue (Selkirk) and a half-brother to the Listed winner Riflescope (Raven's Pass), was offered by Selwood Bloodstock on behalf of breeder Jeremy Gompertz.

"I'm delighted for Jeremy," said Selwood Bloodstock's James Read. "He's been a longstanding client and the mare boards with us. This is a cracking colt and he has gone to a great farm."

Gompertz added: "The mare was bought for me by Adrian Nicoll carrying to Dark Angel and Riflescope, her 2013 foal, emerged as a good horse since. I have retained her yearling by Toronado and she is currently in pre-training. Red Intrigue is in-foal to Muhaarar."
