he Gerald Ryan-trained Trapeze
Artist (Snitzel) proved too strong
for his rivals when he ran out
an impressive winner of the
Expressway Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m) at Rosehill
yesterday and could now be set to clash with
superstar mare Winx (Street Cry) in the Apollo
Stakes (Gr 2, 1400m) at Randwick in two weeks
time

The Golden Rose Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) winner was having his first start since his disappointing display in the Coolmore Stud Stakes (registered as Ascot Vale Stakes) (Gr 1, 1200m) at Flemington in November.

Continued from page 1 The three-year-old colt, who was ridden by Tim Clark, was able to pull clear in the final 200 metres to beat Showtime (Snitzel) by just over length with pre-race favourite Addictive Nature (Savabeel) another head away in third.

Dual Group One winner Global Glamour (Star Witness) finished fourth, with multiple Group One winner Ace High (High Chaparral) finishing fifth, over the unsuitably short trip.

Trapeze Artist broke well from barrier six and was settled in second behind Memes (Time Thief), who set good fractions from the front.

As the field rounded the turn, Trapeze Artist was asked for his

effort and as his rivals began to feel the pinch Showtime was the only one able to live with the pace.

However, Trapeze Artist responded impressively to Clark's urgings to eventually pull away with an impressive victory.

Trapeze Artist can already claim a small victory over Winx this season having beaten her and star sprinter Redzel (Snitzel) when he won his Randwick barrier trial on 22 January.

Ryan said after the race that he had passed the weight-for-age test and deserved his chance to take on the champion mare Winx in the Apollo Stakes.

"He's won at weight-for-age now so we may well take on Winx next," Ryan said.

"He probably shouldn't have gone to Melbourne for the Coolmore Stud Stakes but he has come back well.

"He had about three weeks in the paddock and he's flying.

"He trialled better than I thought he would and was very fit coming into today.

"He is much stronger than he was last time and I would love to win another Group One with him while he is a three-year-old," the trainer continued.

Clark was equally pleased with the colts performance and is confident he can continue to improve.

"That was a really good return," said Clark. "He is the sort of horse that will keep improving this prep. I had to use him a bit to get there but once I come back he travelled well.

"If anything the leader didn't take me far enough so he could left there earlier than I would have liked but he was really strong to the line."

The winner was bred and is raced by the Vieira Group and following yesterday's victory Trapeze Artist (3 c Snitzel - Treppes by Domesday) has won four times in ten starts with one placing for prize money earnings of \$1,073,550.

Continued from page 2 He was offered by the Vieira Group at the 2016 Inglis Australian Easter Yearling Sale but was passed in for \$250,000 with a reserve of \$300,000. Trapeze Artist is the second living foal out of Treppes (Domesday), a placed half-sister to Stradbroke Handicap (Gr 1, 1400m) winner Crawl (Dr Grace) and his Listed-winning brother Old Man (Dr Grace), who was placed at three before being retired to stud.

Treppes is also a half-sister to Step (Grand Lodge), who is the dam of Moonee Valley Vase (Gr 2, 2040m) winner and Caulfield Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) placed Marching (Commands) and Listed winner Gait (Anabaa).

One of two horses to race for Treppes, Trapeze Artist is the first winner for his dam, who missed to Foxwedge (Fastnet Rock) and Pierro (Lonhro) in 2014 and foaled a colt by Zoustar (Northern Meteor) last October who subsequently died in a paddock accident.

She then produced a filly by Newgate Farm's first season sire Wandjina (Snitzel) and has most recently been covered by Snitzel (Redoute's Choice).

Treppes was purchased by Connolly Bloodstock from a Darley reduction at the 2011 Inglis Australian Weanling and Bloodstock Sale for \$55,000 and later purchased by Vieira for \$190,000 in foal to Snitzel when reoffered at the 2014 Magic Millions National Broodmare Sale.

Trapeze Artist is one of 77 stakes winners and 12 Group One winners for Arrowfield Stud-based Snitzel, who was crowned champion sire in Australia last season for the first time.

# Performer returns with narrow Canonbury Stakes win



Odds-on favourite Performer (Exceed And Excel) caused his supporters a few nervous moments yesterday but the unbeaten colt's victory in the Canonbury Stakes (Gr 3, 1100m) has convinced trainer Chris Waller to stick to his Golden Slipper Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) plan.

The Breeders' Plate (Listed, 1000m) winner, who was a one-time favourite for the Golden Slipper Stakes, resumed in yesterday Canonbury Stakes and appeared to have the race in his keeping before runner-up Stratosphere (Snitzel) fought back to be beaten by a nose.

Continued from page 3 The Peter and Paul Snowden-trained Stratosphere (\$9) led the Canonbury Stakes but Performer (\$1.70 favourite) appeared to have his measure with 150 metres to go before the son of Snitzel (Redoute's Choice) almost caused an upset.

The well-supported first starter Exceltic (Excelebration) (\$3.20), who is trained by Gary Portelli, got into the clear late to finish two and a half lengths away in third place.

Performer's jockey Kerrin McEvoy admitted the colt may have peaked on his run in yesterday's Canonbury Stakes.

"He doesn't give you the normal Slipper type of feel in the way he gallops," McEvoy said.

"He is a hard one to put your finger on. I have only ridden him once obviously but I said to Liam (Prior, Waller's assistant) you can't really pigeon hole him into one criteria because he has so many options and avenues he could work into as he gets into his career.

"Whether he is just a speed horse I'm not so sure. He might have just peaked a little bit. I had him out and into full stride at the top of the lane.

"Lucky we got the bob in but he is a nice colt going forward."

Performer will not race until the Todman Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m) and then have his fourth start in the Golden Slipper Stakes at Rosehill on 24 March.

"I know the horse pretty well and he is an exciting horse to be training," Waller said.

"He is a good colt, as is the second horse. I was worried before the :

race, I wasn't worried at the 50 metres but I was the last five metres, that's for sure."

Waller revealed it was some advice from rival trainer John O'Shea who suggested keeping a two-year-old lightly raced into a Golden Slipper Stakes was the best way to win the premier juvenile race.

"Putting it into perspective he has a long way to go until the Golden Slipper. He certainly wasn't wound up today. He has had fitness building trials and had a three-kilogram penalty from the Breeders' Plate," Waller said.


"There is no rush to get to the next race. He is still learning his trade and probably clocked off a little bit and the second horse dug pretty deep. He is an athletic type. He is just where he needs to be.

"I spoke to John O'Shea and he has a bit of experience with these and he said not to over-race them. I went home and had a look at the history."

A \$450,000 purchase by Harras Syndicate / Mulcaster Bloodstock from the Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale in 2017 from the Newhaven Park draft, Performer (2 c Exceed And Excel - Gavroche by Snippets) is a half-brother to the 2013 The Galaxy (Gr 1, 1100m) winner Bel Sprinter (Bel Esprit), while his second dam La Miserable (Miswaki) is a half-sister to the Group One winner Always Aloof (Alleged). From two starts Performer has earned \$192,000.

La Miserable produced six winners from seven foals to race, including the stakes-placed Azelna (Tropular), herself the dam of stakes winner Macias (Purge).

Continued from page 4 His family can be traced further back: to the Group One winners Leading Light (Montjeu) and Toylsome (Cadeaux Genereux), as well as Grade Two winner Dance Parade (Gone West).

Gavroche, who is owned by Seymour Bloodstock, has not had a foal since Performer but was covered on 1 December last year by Fastnet Rock (Danehill).

Performer is one of 142 individual stakes winners for the Darley based stallion Exceed And Excel (Danehill), who last year stood for a fee of \$110,000 (inc GST) for the fourth year in a row.



## Fiesta lands Widden Stakes first up

Widden Stakes (Gr 3, 1100m) winner Fiesta (I Am Invincible), the second leg of a two-year-old stakes double for Chris Waller, yesterday enhanced the leading trainer's juvenile stocks as he chases a maiden Golden Slipper Stakes success.

The two-year-old filly, who was placed in the Gimcrack Stakes (Listed, 1000m) and runner-up in the Kirkham Plate (1000m) in the spring, overcame interference to win her first race in yesterday's \$150,000 Group Three event.

Fiesta (\$3.90), who was ridden by Kerrin McEvoy, defeated Adamina :

(Snitzel) (\$31) by a short neck with River Bird (Epaulette) (\$18) two lengths away in third place.

Waller also won the previous race, the Canonbury Stakes. with two-year-old Performer.

Fiesta settled in a midfield position and McEvoy attempted to



take the filly to the outside in the straight to make her run, but was held in a pocket by a rival runner.

The scrimmage forced McEvoy to dart back towards the inside fence on the filly, who made ground late to score.

"It was a good effort to see her win after a bit of a scrimmage. The horse to her outside of her wasn't going anywhere but fortunately the gap opened on the inside and Kerrin saw it," Waller said.

"It is good to see a young horse under pressure still quicken after copping a bump in the race. It might look easy watching at home but I can tell you those midrace clashes at high speeds would be like being hit with a pretty solid object." Continued on page 6>>

"It was a pretty good win. There was a bit of hustle and bustle involved and she over-raced a bit with the blinkers on, so I was a bit concerned at the 500 metres that I might have used up a bit of gas," McEvoy said.

"After a bit of a bump and having to change course she didn't lose focus. She was the winner as soon as I got that gap.

"If I got beat I still would have been happy with the run because of the energy she used early. It was full or merit."

Waller intends to target the Golden Slipper Stakes with Fiesta, who will tackle the lead-up fillies races before the 24 March feature race where she will take on the colts and geldings.

Fiesta (2fI Am Invincible - Now Now by Danehill Dancer) has now had three starts for two placings and yesterday's Group Three victory for prize money of \$117,150.

The I Am Invincible (Invincible Spirit) filly is a daughter of five-time winning metropolitan-placed sprinter Now Now (Danehill Dancer), who is a half-sister to the South African Group Two runner-up Rock Cocktail (Rock Of Gibraltar).

A \$150,000 purchase at the 2017 Inglis Classic Yearling Sale by Star Thoroughbreds and Chris Waller Racing from the Fairhill Farm draft, Fiesta is one of four foals to race and one of two winners for Now Now.

The filly's third dam is the Listed winner Vowed (Without Fear), who had eight foals to race for six winners including stakes winners Stick Around (Twig Moss), Charm Scene Land (Brocco) and Kingsgate (Danzero).

Now Now has a weanling colt by Outreach (Exceed And Excel) and was covered by Capitalist (Written Tycoon) on 15 October last year.

Fiesta's victory was also a boon for her breeder, Fairhill Farm's Mike O'Donnell, with Inglis paying him \$100,000 as part of an Inglis bonus scheme.

The I Am Invincible filly was bought as part of the Blue Riband session at the Inglis Classic Yearling Sale last year, with the connections of the first graduate of the session to win a two-year-old stakes race entitled to a \$100,000 bonus split equally between the vendor and supplier of the yearling.

"I obviously knew about the bonus that it existed but when I got the call from Jonathan [D'Arcy] earlier it was a bloody nice surprise," O'Donnell said.

"And what perfect timing, a day before we take our draft to Classic for this year's sale where we've got 10 horses and a very nice Hinchinbrook colt (Lot 91) in Gold Riband next Saturday night.

"I'll tell you one thing, Fiesta is a tough thing. She got hit at the start, she over-raced, she couldn't get out in the straight yet she still won."

Fiesta's sire I Am Invincible has now sired 26 individual stakes winners including three at Group One level, Brazen Beau, I Am A Star and Viddora.

I Am Invincible, who stands at Yarraman Park Stud near Scone, stood at a fee of \$110,000 (inc GST) last year. He was the leading sire by average (with three or more lots sold) at last month's Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale where 37 yearlings by the sire sold for \$17,710,000 at an average of \$478,649.

## Fiesta, who works regularly with : Impressive debut Inglis Premier victory for Kinky Boom

Dual-state trainer Tony McEvoy admits he was hesitant to send two-year-old Kinky Boom (Spirit Of Boom) to Melbourne so soon after a dominant barrier trial victory, but the gamble paid off yesterday when the filly landed an impressive debut victory in the \$250,000 Inglis Premier (RL, 1200m).

The daughter of Spirit Of Boom (Segualo) barrier trialled over 1000 metres at Morphettville Parks last Monday, winning by eight and a half lengths, which saw her immediately dispatched to McEvoy's Flemington stable ahead of yesterday's lucrative Inglis graduates two-year-old race.

Ridden by Craig Williams, Kinky Boom (\$3.70 equal favourite) was slowly away and settled last on the fence before the filly worked into the race by the home turn before being switched three wide in the straight to round up the leader and stablemate Aristocratic Miss (Foxwedge) to win by one and three quarter lengths.

The Robbie Griffiths-trained Grand Symphony (Glass Harmonium) (\$41) also made up ground to finished second, a half length in front of Aristocratic Miss (\$4.60).

McEvoy said after the race Kinky Boom was now likely to contest the Blue Diamond Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) at Caulfield on 24 February.

"That money gets us to the big dance," McEvoy said.

"Three weeks out it's too hard to pass up when you have a filly of this ability."

McEvoy said Kinky Boom was set to trial at Gawler on 22 January but refused to load into the barriers.

"That panicked us a bit and my son Calvin and John Cornell got to work on her getting her in the gates with an intensive little program,"

"We got her to the Morphettville trials on Monday and she did what she did and that left us no choice but to come over and she proved up to

"She'll be tired tomorrow but the beauty is she has three weeks into the Diamond from here."

Jockey Craig Williams, who won last year's Blue Diamond Stakes on the Lindsay Park-trained Catchy (Fastnet Rock), said Kinky Boom reminded him of other fillies he rode in the lead-up to last year's race. Continued on page 7>>

but she's got the makings of being a huge contender in the Blue Diamond," Williams said.

"Last year I had the choice of five rides in the Blue Diamond but that (Kinky Boom) was quite special today."

A \$40,000 Inglis Premier Yearling Sale session two purchase by McEvoy Mitchell Racing from the Phoenix Broodmare Farm

draft last year, Kinky Boom (2 f Spirit Of Boom - Kinka Rhode by Encosta De Lago) provided an immediate return for her owners which include breeder Eureka Stud. Yesterday's win earned connections \$137,500 in prize money.

Kinky Boom is one of two winners from three foals to race out of the four-time winning Encosta De Lago (Fairy King) mare Kinka Rhode, who was victorious from 1200 metres to 2400 metres.

The filly's second dam is the New Zealand Listed winner Centennial (Centaine), herself a half-sister to fellow stakes-winning mare Brianna (Sudurka).

Kinka Rhode was purchased by Eureka Stud for just \$600 at the Inglis Scone Thoroughbred Sale in 2014 from the Glastonbury Farms draft.

The mare was not in foal at the time and was subsequently covered by Eureka Stud's resident stallion Spirit Of Boom at his first year at stud, producing Kinky Boom the following August.

Kinka Rhode has a yearling colt by Turffontein (Johannesburg) and a weanling colt by Spirit Of Boom. She was again covered by Spirit Of Boom last September.

"It really is a win for the families, the McAlpines, the McEvoys and the Inglis family, many of which make up a good part of the ownership and obviously training team of this filly," Eureka Stud's Scott McAlpine said.

"Spirit Of Boom is going so well, it really is hard to get your head around what he's achieved so far and this filly Kinky Boom, she was always a very intelligent filly, a very athletic filly and while she was never huge as a young horse, she's developed into an outstanding type."

Damian Gleeson and Deb Gifford of Phoenix Broodmare Farm retained a ten per cent share in Kinky Boom after last year's Melbourne Premier Yearling Sale, something they rarely do.

"But we just knew she was special, we knew she had an X-factor of some description," Gleeson said.

"This is awesome, just awesome. To share this moment and this hopefully long ride with such great people really makes it all worthwhile."

The former Tony Gollan-trained sprinter Spirit Of Boom is currently the leading first crop stallion by winners, with nine individual two-year-old winners so far this season.

Kinky Boom is also one of four juvenile stakes winners for her sire, joining Jonker, Ef Troop and Outback Barbie.

Spirit Of Boom stood at Queensland-based Eureka Stud last year for a fee of \$11,000 (inc GST). He has seven lots catalogued for next week's Inglis Classic Yearling Sale.

## "It's still three weeks away : Blue Diamond Stakes next on the agenda for **Ennis Hill**

A tilt at the Blue Diamond Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) in three weeks now lies in wait for the Lindsay Park-trained Ennis Hill (Fastnet Rock) after she finally

lived up to her stables high expectations with effortless performance to win the Chairman's Stakes (Gr 3, 1000m) at Caulfield yesterday.

Ennis Hill came into yesterday's race having run fourth on debut, after being forced wide, over 1100 metres at Caulfield in December, but a much smoother passage under Stephen Baster this time saw her come away with a length and a half victory over Encryption (Lonhro) with another length and a quarter back to Prairie Fire (Snitzel) in third.

With blinkers on for the first time, the two-year-old took the lead early in the 1000 metre race and the result never looked in doubt and the victory prompted bookmakers to slash her odds for the Blue Diamond Stakes.

"She did what we thought she would do," co-trainer Ben Hayes said. "In her first start, she didn't. It just shows they can get it wrong.

"She just needed the run to come on and the blinkers really did the trick with her.

"She jumped better today and she just never looked like losing."

The stable won last year's Chairman's Stakes with Formality (Fastnet Rock), who subsequently went on to finish third behind stablemate Catchy (Fastnet Rock) in the Blue Diamond Stakes, and Hayes said Ennis Hill reminded him of Formality.

Baster was also impressed by Ennis Hill and is confident the step up in distance will not prove a problem for the daughter of Fastnet Rock.

"The 1000 metres suits her because she's fast but she's got a lot of quality about her so I don't see why she's not going to get 1200 metres," he said.

Lindsay Park has a number of two-year-olds in Blue Diamond contention, headed by unbeaten colt Long Leaf (Fastnet Rock), who is the \$7 favourite.

Ennis Hill (2 f Fastnet Rock - Hips Don't Lie by Stravinsky) is out of the Group Two-winning Stravinsky (Nureyev) mare Hips Don't Lie, making the filly a sister to stakes-winning filly Lady Geneva and a further three winners.

Hips Don't Lie is out of Procure (Centaine), who produced six winners including Hips Don't Lie and the dam of Mr Tiz Trophy (Gr 3, 1200m) winner No More Tears (Darci Brahma).

Procure herself is out of Gimcrack Stakes (Listed, 1000m) winner Getting There (Jungle Boy), making her a half-sister to Group Three winner Rythm (Bakharoff) and Listed winners Tristachine (Sir Tristram) and Western Music (Western Symphony).

The win also provided Coolmore shuttler Fastnet Rock with his 128th stakes winner.

## **128 for Fastnet Rock**

The Lindsay Park-trained Ennis Hill (2 f ex Hips Don't Lie by Stravinsky) put in an impressive display to land the Chairman's Stakes (Gr 3, 1000m) at Caulfield yesterday and in the process became the 128th stakes winner for Coolmore shuttler Fastnet Rock (Danehill). The Coolmoreraced filly finished fourth on debut at the same track after being sent off the favourite, but yesterday the result never looked in any doubt when she powered home to beat Encryption (Lonhro) by a length and a half with another length and a guarter back to Prairie Road (Snitzel) in third. Former champion sire in Australia, Fastnet Rock had 28 yearlings sale for a total aggregate of \$9,520,000 at an average of \$340,000 at last month's Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale.

## 26 for I Am Invincible

The Yarraman Park-based sire I Am Invincible (Invincible Spirit) was vesterday provided with his 26th stakes winner when the Chris Wallertrained Fiesta (2 f ex Now Now by Danehill Dancer) narrowly landed the Widden Stakes (Gr 3, 1100m) at Rosehill. The two-year-old ran third in the Gimcrack Stakes (Listed, 1000m) at Randwick on debut before finishing second at the same track in October and yesterday she was able to shake her maiden status, defeating the \$31 outsider Adamina (Snitzel) by a head with a further two lengths back to River Bird (Epaulette) in third. I Am Invincible finished the leading sire by aggregate at the recent Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling, after 37 lots sold for a total gross of \$17,710,000 and he was also responsible for the sale's top lot, a colt out of Tai Tai Tess (Magic Albert), which was purchased for \$2,000,000 by Reg Inglis, Jon Kelly and Paul Frampton.

## **Four for Spirit Of Boom**

Kinky Boom (2 f ex Kinka Rhode by Encosta De Lago) backed up an emphatic barrier trial

victory on Monday to win yesterday's Inglis Premier (RL, 1200m) at Caulfield at her first start, providing her freshman sire Spirit Of Boom (Segualo) with his ninth individual first crop winner and fourth stakes winner. The Tony McEvoy-trained juvenile won a Morphettville barrier trial by eight and a half lengths, prompting a trip to Melbourne for the \$250,000 race. Settling last, jockey Craig Williams worked into the race at the top of the straight to ease three wide to defeat Grand Symphony (Glass Harmonium) by a length and three quarters, with the filly's stablemate Aristocratic Miss (Foxwedge) another half a length away in third. Kinky Boom joins Ef Troop, Outback Barbie and Jonker as stakes winners for the Eureka Stud-based Spirit Of Boom, who is currently leading Australia's first season sire standings by winners.

## 24 for Bel Esprit

The Sun Stud-based stallion Bel Esprit (Royal Academy) sired his 24th stakes winner yesterday courtesy of the Aaron Purcell-trained Lady Esprit's (5 m ex Fanciful Bella by Bellotto) shock victory in the W J Adams Stakes (Listed, 1000m) at Caulfield. Lady Esprit had not been successful since she January 2017 and as result was sent off an unfancied \$51 chance, but she was able to storm back into form and beat the heavily backed \$1.75 favourite Snitty Kitty (Snitzel) by a quarter of a length. Bel Esprit stood at Sun Stud's Queensland base in 2017 for a fee of \$12,100 (inc GST).

# Purcell pleased with Lady Esprit

After Lady Esprit's surprise victory in the W J Adams Stakes at Caulfield yesterday, winning trainer Aaron Purcell admitted he wasn't sure going into the race whether she was good enough to win. "We didn't know if she was good enough but there you go," Purcell said. "We probably didn't really want to be racing Snitty Kitty today but with her rating there wasn't a lot

of options for her. We were hoping she would be able to run a place but obviously she's a stakes winner now, which is really good. With get-back sprinters, you always need luck. It didn't work out at all last start. Today it's worked out really well "

## Cliff's Edge returns with Manfred Stakes win

Promising three-year-old Cliff's Edge (Canford Cliffs) is likely to be aimed at the Australian Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) at Flemington next month after a first up victory in yesterday's Manfred Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m) at Caulfield. Trainer Darren Weir says Cliff's Edge, who won the Manfred Stakes yesterday, would benefit significantly from yesterday's victory as he heads towards the Australian Guineas. "He's a beauty," Weir said. "He landed in a beautiful spot and he was travelling up well behind them on the corner. He just needed the gap to come and he went back to the inside and won extremely well. He's just a real racehorse." Cliff's Edge is now the \$5 favourite for the Australian Guineas ahead of Thousand Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) winner Aloisia (Azamour). "He'll take good benefit from that today and he'll head to the CS Hayes Stakes in a fortnight," Weir said. "He's on a Guineas path. It was a big tick today to head down that way but he's got to keep doing it. It looks like he's on track at this stage."

# The Vanity next for undefeated Paris Rock

Trainer Henry Dwyer is eyeing a tilt in The Vanity (Gr 3, 1200m) at Flemington on 17 February with Paris Rock (Rock 'n' Pop) after she was able to preserve her perfect record in the Ian Miller Handicap (1400m) at Caulfield yesterday. The three-year-old won her first two career starts at Geelong and Ballarat and yesterday she stayed on strongly all the way to the line to beat Earth Angel (Animal Kingdom) by three quarters of a length with another length and three quarters back to Lucky Cat (Star Witness) in third. "After today I think she deserves a shot at a stakes race," Dwyer said. "She keeps improving all the time and they're the ones that make good horses."

# Adelaide Cup on Double Bluff's radar

Another tilt at the Adelaide Cup (Gr 2, 3200m) at Morphettville on 12 March could now be on Double Bluff's (Azamour) agenda after his impressive victory in yesterday's Robert Hunter Handicap (2400m) at Caulfield. The Robbie Laing-trained seven-year-old, who ran second in the Group Two last season, stayed on strongly to overhaul Dornier (Artie Schiller) by a quarter of a length. "When he should have been joining in on the turn he was running into dead ends and we thought he should have nearly won (Adelaide Cup)," Laing said. "We'll be there hopefully winning it this year."

# Bedford chalks up another win at Caulfield

Trainer Anthony Freedman believes time has been the key to Bedford's (Tavistock) recent turnaround in form as he chalked up a second successive victory at Caulfield yesterday by taking out the Mal Seccull Handicap (2000m). The four-year-old gelding stayed on stoutly to defeat O'Lonera (O'Lonhro) by a head with Archery Peak (Arch) another length and a quarter away in third. "He's a horse that wasn't going anywhere six months ago so he's probably matured a bit and is now starting to put together a nice record," Freedman said. "He might even be better in another six months as there's not much of him and he might strengthen up a bit. Maybe he can go to the

Mornington Cup if he continues with his form. It's worth \$300,000 and it's around the corner from home."

# Eurack's perfect record intact

The Nathan McPherson-trained Eurack (Oneworld) stretched her unbeaten record to four when she landed the Ladbrokes Handicap (1100m) at Caulfield yesterday. Having her first start since August, Eurack lad all the way under Ben Melham to beat Handsome Thief (Shamardal) by threequarters of a length with Highland Beat (Exceed And Excel) a neck away third. "She's pretty special and she's going to attract a big following now," McPherson said. "I'm going to have to get used to this for a little while longer. We'll get her home, get recovery into her and aim for Flemington in a few more weeks. I think if we can keep giving her a look at these lesser races while she's having a look at those tracks she will keep improving."

"She'll get better, she's still learning. She'll get 2000 metres and in good company," Tubman said. "Winona (Costin, jockey) rode her brilliantly. She's a good little rider. She doesn't get the opportunities she should get."

# Overdue win for High Opinion

High Opinion (Lord Jim) bounced back from a luckless run over 2000 metres at Randwick by taking out a Benchmark 81 (2000m) at Rosehill yesterday. # Rare offering of a genuine Classic prospect sees auction record smashed

f you think hen's teeth are a rare thing, then you should trying finding a colt in training with genuine Classic credentials at public auction.

However, that is precisely what was served up when Willie John (Dansili) came on the market during the second leg of the Tattersalls February Sale on Friday, and it was trainer Roger Varian who emerged victorious from the high-stakes showdown with an auction-record bid of 1,900,000 guineas.

It had been a relatively low-key day of trade until former William Haggas-trained Willie John tiptoed between the acorns, but the presence of the unbeaten son of Dansili (Danehill) saw bids begin to rain down from all sides of the Park Paddocks ring.

Oliver St Lawrence, Ed Dunlop and Hugo
Lascelles got the ball rolling with a rapid-fire
exchange, and by the time the likes of Anthony
Stroud and Julian Dollar joined in the bids
were coming so thick and fast that potential

purchasers could barely get their hands in the air quick enough.

It eventually boiled down to a duel between Cheveley Park Stud's Chris Richardson and Roger Varian, who were situated in the two stairwells opposite Edmond Mahony's rostrum, and it was the Newmarket-based trainer that delivered the decisive nod of the head to signal a bid of 1,900,000 guineas on behalf of Sheikh Mohammed Obaid.

Catalogued as Lot 379, Willie John was a 325,000 guineas Book One yearling and was another February Sale lot to have been partowned by disgraced South African billionaire Markus Jooste, who has been forced to close down his global racing empire amid a string of accountancy fraud allegations.

The three-year-old made the track just once while under the care of Haggas, but created a big impression when overcoming clear signs of inexperience to land a Yarmouth novice stakes by clear water.

"He obviously won well on his only start and the owner already has an interest in the family," said Varian. "He bought the Dubawi colt out of the mare in the autumn and identified this colt as a horse he'd like and we're very lucky to have been able to do the steering for him. I'm looking forward to getting to know the horse a little better now."

During last year's renewal of Book One of the Tattersalls October Yearling Sale Varian went to 2,600,000 guineas to secure Willie John's half-brother by Dubawi (Dubai Millennium).

The pair were bred by Meon Valley Stud and are out of dual Group One winner Izzi Top (Pivotal), a daughter of Pivotal (Polar Falcon) whose two runners to date remain unbeaten, with her Oasis Dream (Green Desert) colt Dreamfield having landed two races for Godolphin.

"He's a promising horse and he's got a great pedigree," continued Varian. "Those autumn maidens at Yarmouth are often pretty strong."

The son of Dansili was offered with entries in the Derby (Gr 1, 1m4f) at Epsom and the Irish equivalent, but the Carlburg Stables-based handler was in no rush to identify a starting point for his new charge.

"I don't think we need to worry about where he's going to debut for us - I'm just looking forward to getting him in the yard," he said, before offering an update on Willie John's 2,600,000 guineas Dubawi half-brother, saying: "He's cantering and looks a jolly nice horse but it's still early days."

## No Relenting

The day's second-top lot was Relent, a daughter of Dansili offered by Juddmonte who went the way of Cathy Grassick for 220,000 guineas. The unraced three-year-old was acquired on behalf of Yvonne Jacques of Carisbrooke Stud, the operation formerly known as Lady Whent's Raffin Stud.

Catalogued as Lot 375, Relent is a half-sister to Grade Two winner Projected (Showcasing) and is out of a half-sister to the globe-trotting Flintshire (Dansili), while Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe (Gr 1, 2400m) heroine Enable (Nathaniel) also appears further down the page.

"She has the pedigree and the looks," said Grassick, who was accompanied in the bidding area by her client. "Yvonne Jacques has set up Carisbrooke Stud, which is being managed by Joe Grimwade, and she's looking for topclass stock and this filly is a no-brainer with everything that's happening on the page."

The relationship between Grassick and Jacques, who has horses in training with William Haggas, Marco Botti, Jeremy Noseda and Varian, has blossomed following the purchase of two yearling fillies, Appealing (Bertolini) and Grandeur (Verglas).

"Appealing, a €7,500 yearling, was second in the Yellow Ribbon, and the other was Grandeur who was a multiple Grade Two winner and Grade One-placed in America. That was the start of a beautiful relationship! When you start off with two fillies like that it's a dream come true," said Grassick.

"I think we'll have to look very seriously at Nathaniel," added Grassick on the subject of coverings for Relent. "Given the fact that she's a Dansili and Enable is there on the page."

## Zenon master

This progressive staying handicapper Zenon is set to join the powerhouse stable of Willie Mullins after Harold Kirk went to 120,000 guineas to secure the son of Galileo (Sadler's Wells). The four-year-old boasts a peak Racing Post Rating of 101 having landed two handicaps in 2017 while under the care of John Gosden.

"He's a strong horse and a good stayer," said Kirk. "He came recommended, and we've been lucky with John Gosden in the past through the likes of Nichols Canyon and Thomas Hobson.

"This horse is already rated 96 on the Flat, so he's no slouch. We'll get him gelded and then he could go jumping before going down the staying route on the Flat."

Catalgoued as Lot 394, Zenon is out of the King Charlemagne (Nureyev) mare Jacqueline, a leading filly in India at 6f to 1m4f.

## **Barberini's Treasure**

After a lukewarm beginning it fell to another horse that had been part-owned by Jooste to get proceedings underway in earnest, as Federico Barberini went to 60,000 guineas for Giant's Treasure on behalf of Steve Parkin's Clipper Logistics. The colt was catalogued as Lot 302.

The four-year-old son of Shamardal (Giant's Causeway), a 525,000 guineas Book One graduate, made just the one start for Jooste and the China Horse Club, but went some way to justifying his lofty yearling price when running out an impressive winner of a Wolverhampton maiden last March for Richard Hannon - who was among the underbidders.

"What we've seen of him has been impressive," said Barberini. "He's been off a

while but he could be a serious horse - it was nice to see that his trainer was brave enough to bid on him himself.

"He has been bought for Clipper Logistics but there is no plan yet. I don't even know who will train him. He's very good looking - he was an expensive yearling - and he has a pedigree as well. It's very exciting to have got him."

In total seven horses that had been under the part ownership of Jooste were offered across the two days, with the septet registering a combined 3,738,000 guineas, 92 per cent of the aggregate sales.

## **Figures**

The two days of selling saw 154 of 168 offered lots change hands for turnover of 4,044,500 guineas - up a thumping 64 per cent year-on-year, an average of 26,265 guineas up a huge 93 per cent. However, the median dropped from 8,500 guineas to 7,500 guineas, while the clearance rate remained on par at a healthy 92 per cent.

In his end of sale address, Tattersalls' chairman Edmond Mahony said: "Last year's Tattersalls February Sale reached unprecedented levels for this fixture with turnover of more than double the record 2016 sale and an average price up 56 per cent, so to surpass those figures is another phenomenal achievement, especially with a smaller catalogue.

"The obvious highlight was the 1,900,000 guineas sale of the outstanding Classic prospect Willie John and it is a wonderful

endorsement of the February Sale that, although one of our newer and smaller sales, it now holds the distinction of producing the highest priced colt in training ever sold at public auction in Europe.

"The 500,000 guineas previous record price for the February Sale has been surpassed four times in the past two days, demonstrating beyond any doubt that the February Sale is a sale which consistently produces optimum prices for quality thoroughbreds, while at the same time serving as a perfect seasonal outlet for stock at all levels of the market.

"As ever, the international demand has been a feature of the sale and in addition to strong European participation, buyers from throughout the Gulf region, America, Hong Kong, Japan and South Africa have all made a significant contribution to a record breaking start to 2018 at Tattersalls."


