Brilliant Winx reigns supreme in Queen Elizabeth Stakes

Champion mare equals Black Caviar's 25 race winning sequence

Almost three years to the day since her last defeat, Winx (Street Cry) has done the unthinkable and equalled Black Caviar's (Bel Esprit) record of 25 straight wins.

The champion mare and darling of Australian racing proved too strong in the

Queen Elizabeth Stakes (Gr 1, 2000m) for a determined Gailo Chop (Deportivo), with perennial chaser of the great mare, Happy Clapper (Teofilo), back in third.

After settling last, Winx was given time by her long-time jockey Hugh Bowman, before circling the ten-horse field and delivering the blistering turn of foot that she is so well known for, to win by almost four lengths. *Continued on page 2>>*

Seven-time Group One winner Highland Reel to shuttle to Swettenham Stud

Swettenham Stud has announced that the former Aidan O'Brien-trained, multiple Group One-winning globe-trotter Highland Reel (Galileo) will shuttle to the Victorian farm this spring, where he will stand for a fee of \$15,000 (plus GST).

Highland Reel enjoyed remarkable success on the track over a four-year period, with his first career landmark coming as a two-year-old when he was successful in the Vintage Stakes (Gr 2, 7f) at Goodwood. *Morning Briefing page 12 >>*

<< *Continued from page 1* The wonder mare has done what Black Caviar did before her, transcending horse racing to grab the hearts of Australians everywhere and speaking pre-race, trainer Chris Waller acknowledged the rarity of what his mare has done.

"Our sporting friends join us on these days and embrace our sport," he said.

Indeed, little was left to be done as Winx walked out onto the track for Waller who, as we've come to expect, was noticeably nervous.

"It doesn't get any easier, race day, but once the day is finally here, I've done my job. Hugh is a fantastic jockey and he'll do the very best he can as he always does and we're just in the lap of the racing gods now." Waller said.

However, once the race was run, Waller was effusive in his praise for the mare and horse racing itself.

"We've got an amazing sport and it drives us all to reach our dreams," an emotional Waller said.

"It's hard to explain, she's our girl, she's our daughter and our love child. She's just a beautiful, beautiful animal."

Jockey Hugh Bowman has ridden Winx in every start since her 2015 Epsom Handicap (Gr 1, 1600m) win and the association he has with the mare will enshrine his name in the record books.

"As a child you grow up wanting fairytales to come true and I grew up wanting to be a jockey. Being in horse racing and being a jockey has been my life and my family's life since I began 20 years ago, and this horse is just such an exceptional individual," Bowman said.

"To be associated with her comes with a huge level of responsibility, but at the end of the day I just have so much faith in her and I've just got to have her happy.

"I can't make miracles happen, all I can do is have her comfortable and let her do her job. What an amazing thrill she gives me," Bowman said.

The 28th victory and 25th win in a row was also Winx's second success in the \$4,000,000 Queen Elizabeth, taking her earnings to an Australian prize-money record of \$18,998,425.


Bred by John Camilleri's Fairway Thoroughbreds, Winx (6 m Street Cry - Vegas Showgirl by Al Akbar) was purchased by Magic Bloodstock for \$230,000 out of the Coolmore Stud draft at the 2013 Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale.

She is one of six named foals out of the dual Listed winner Vegas Showgirl (Al Akbar), who was crowned Australian Broodmare of the Year for the second time last August.

The daughter of Al Akbar (Success Express) is also the dam of the 2016 Kindergarten Stakes (Gr 3, 1100m) dead-heat winner El Divino (Snitzel), and Boulder City, an unraced three-year-old colt by Snitzel (Redoute's Choice) who topped the 2016 Inglis Australian Easter Yearling Sale when selling for \$2,300,000 to Gai Waterhouse and Blue Sky Bloodstock.

Vegas Showgirl is out of the dual winner Vegas Magic (Voodoo Rhythm) and a half-sister to the Group Three-placed Black Magic Maggie (Westminster). Vegas Showgirl foaled a filly by Snitzel in 2016, which is to be retained to race by Camilleri. On 16 September last year, Vegas Showgirl produced a filly by Exceed And Excel (Danehill) at Segenhoe Stud in the Hunter Valley, before missing to the Darley shuttler last October.

Unforgotten reels in Hiyaam to land Australian Oaks

The formidable combination of Chris Waller and Hugh Bowman made sure that Saturday would be a memorable one, with the aptly named filly Unforgotten (Fastnet Rock) storming clear to win the ATC Australian Oaks (Gr 1, 2400m) by one length over her Vinery Stud Stakes (registered as Storm Queen Stakes) (Gr 1, 2000m) conqueror Hiyaam (High Chaparral), with that filly's stablemate, Miss Admiration (Sebring) in third.

After a few unlucky moments earlier in the day, Bowman looked after Unforgotten in a fast-run race to combine with Waller for their 30th Group One win together.

In turning the tables on Hiyaam, Unforgotten earned her fifth win out of nine starts, and importantly her first Group One after capturing the Phar Lap Stakes (Gr 2, 1500m) two starts back.

Despite a tough start to the day, Bowman was confident in the filly after riding her in her work on Tuesday.

"I've been beaten on three favourites already today - just because they're favourites, doesn't mean they're going to win. It's up to me to get the job done and I feel a responsibility to do that for the people watching," Bowman said.

"I was very confident with this filly coming into the race, after riding her work on Tuesday just before I did the wonder mare.

"She gave me a really good feel and I wasn't really too concerned about the trip. I was just concerned about having luck in running and the strong gallop set up by Mick Dee and Hiyaam made for a very fair race and everyone got their chance, and my filly proved her dominance."

In winning Saturday's race, Unforgotten became Waller's second Australian Oaks winner after Royal Descent (Redoute's Choice) won the race by ten lengths in 2013 on a heavy track.

However, going into Saturday, the champion trainer was not sure his filly would see out the distance.

"When I did see that speed, like everybody else, obviously the first question was her stamina and whether it would hold up because for a three-year-old it's quite a long way and 2400 metres, you don't know until you run it," Waller said.

<< *Continued from page 4* "She had the perfect run, the way the race was run. The filly that ran second was the horse that beat her home last start so we knew that was the one to chase. She set about chasing and it was good to see her get the upper hand with about 100 metres to go.

"You never stop worrying in this job. I think she's got a very bright future, that's the exciting part of this win today."

A NZ\$360,000 purchase at the 2016 New Zealand Bloodstock National Yearling Sale by Chris Waller Racing from the Curraghmore draft, Unforgotten (3 f Fastnet Rock - Memories Of You by Galileo) has won five of her nine starts for prize money of \$1,095,520.

Unforgotten is one of three winners out of the unplaced European-bred mare Memories Of You (Galileo), who is a half-sister to Group One winner Matiara (Bering), Group Two winners Pyrus (Mr Prospector) and Marathon (Diesis) and Listed winner Precious Ring (Bering).

Unforgotten's sister is the Listed-placed Special Memories, who also ran fourth in the New Zealand 1,000 Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) at Riccarton, while her second dam is the juvenile-winning Listed winner Most Precious (Nureyev). Her third dam is the European Listed winner Miss Summer (Luthier).

Memories Of You has a weanling colt by Coolmore shuttler No Nay Never (Scat Daddy) and was covered last year by fellow shuttler Air Force Blue (War Front).

With an electrifying turn of foot, Alizee stormed down the outside to outclass Prompt Response (Beneteau) and Heavens Above (Street Cry) in the big field of fillies and mares.

<< *Continued from page 6* Winning trainer, James Cummings, made the decision to drop her back in distance after the filly struggled to see out the distance in the Vinery Stakes (registered as Storm Queen Stakes) (Gr 1, 2000m) at her last start.

The formline proved to be one to follow on Saturday, after it earlier provided the trifecta in the ATC Australian Oaks (Gr 1, 2400m).

Cummings said: "She's the best three-year-old in the country, I think. She returned with a blistering win first-up over six-furlongs on a good track and we just waited to get her back to Randwick, a track that suits her.

"The team had her in perfect condition today, she was fully wound up and she showed what she can do when she gets a Randwick mile under her belt. She absolutely loves it."

The Godolphin stable have a lot of exciting prospects coming from the family of Alizee, thanks to the filly's mother, Essaouira (Exceed And Excel).

"We've got a filly as good as her, she's the sister of Astern of course who is at stud, and a Brazen Beau colt by her (Essaouira) and he's one of our best colts in the stable. What a family!" Cummings said.

"We had Alizee here in perfect condition and she just blew them away, so we can all be proud," he said, after a tough day of racing for the stable after their Viridine (Poet's Voice) was blocked for a run in the Arrowfield 3YO Sprint (registered as Royal Sovereign Stakes) (Gr 2, 1200m) as favourite earlier on Saturday.

Ridden by Glyn Schofield, Saturday's win was the Godolphin filly's fifth win out of 14 career starts, and all of her wins have come in her breakout three-year-season.

Schofield has ridden Alizee in every one of those wins and was effusive in his praise for the filly.

"She's special to begin with, so it makes it a little bit easier to ride the good ones," Schofield said.

"She's got such a turn of speed, and I allowed her to use it today. I would have liked to be closer (in the run), but I had to come back to get in and then she just unleashed."

"This was her race all along for the autumn carnival, so it was great for the team to get the just rewards," said Schofield.

Alizee (3 f Sepoy - Essaouira by Exceed And Excel) is one of five winning foals out of Essaouira and the second Group One winner after Astern (Medaglia d'Oro), while she is her sire's only Group One winner to date, and takes her prize money to \$1,410,350 from fourteen starts.

Her second dam is the Group Two winner Alizes (Rory's Jester), while her third dam La Baraka (Euclase) won six races including the 1998 The Galaxy (Gr 1, 1100m).

La Baraka is one of seven winners out of the champion mare and five-time Group One winner Triscay (Marscay), who also produced Group Two winner Tsuimai (Thunder Gulch) and stakes placegetter Robrick (Grand Lodge).

Who Shot Thebarman caps memorable day for Waller in Cup



Who Shot Thebarman

Who Shot Thebarman (Yamanin Vital), the veteran nine-year-old gelding, finally won the Sydney Cup (Gr 1, 3200m) on what was his fifth shot at the contest.

The 156th running of the race was decided by only a nose, with Chris Waller's fan favourite getting the nod over Zacada (Zabeel) from the Murray Baker and Andrew Forsman stable, with Sir Charles Road (Myboycharlie) grabbing third spot one length away.

Having run second in 2015 and 2017, Who Shot Thebarman was given a soft run in the staying test by Blake Shinn, and gave trainer, Chris Waller, his third consecutive Group One win on Saturday.

Waller trained the gelding to perfection, having had his final lead-up run in the H E Tancred Stakes (Gr 1, 2400m) stakes a fortnight ago, where he ran third to 2016 Melbourne Cup (Gr 1, 3200m) winner Almandin (Monsun).

The four kilogram drop in the weights was appreciated by Who Shot Thebarman and Waller was relieved that his gelding had finally got the job done, after placing in the 2014 Melbourne Cup.

"He's been such a frustrating horse because he's run so many seconds, thirds in Melbourne Cups and Sydney Cups and given us one helluva ride," Waller said.

"He's nine years old and if Winx isn't a pretty good advertisement on how to look after a horse, then 'Thebarman' takes the cake."

"It just shows that we're not a one-horse stable and every horse gets the care and attention, and we're so bloody proud of it," Waller said.

The champion trainer reflected on the upside of being scratched from last year's Melbourne Cup, which gave Who Shot Thebarman time to rest before an autumn campaign.

"Last year he had to be scratched when he had a temperature and I said to the owners 'don't panic', because at least he won the Moonee Valley Gold Cup, and we've still got a horse left for a Sydney Cup, and we didn't panic," said Waller.

Indeed, so tough is the New Zealand-bred galloper that he ran in the

Sydney Cup twice in 2017, and placed second on both occasions after the first running of the race was deemed a no-race

Blake Shinn has ridden the gelding thirteen times, and while only winning twice on Who Shot Thebarman, has also been narrowly beaten in the aforementioned Sydney Cups, and the 2016 The BMW, where he was defeated by his stablemate Preferment (Zabeel) who now stands at stud at Brighthill Farm in New Zealand.

"You get an understanding of their traits. He's a little bit of a quirky horse, he hasn't got a sharp turn of foot, but he keeps giving for you," Shinn said.

"Fortunately I got on the back of Almandin and then from the 700 (metres) I just rode a race and got him out and blended into it. It just worked out it was one of those lucky races for me."

Saturday's win was Who Shot Thebarman's (9 g Yamanin Vital - Ears Carol by Carolingian) 11th win in 51 starts and takes his earnings to \$4,655,586.

The gelding is out of the unraced Ears Carol (Carolingian), who has produced five winners from five foals to race. His second dam is Auditive (Random Chance), who is herself a daughter of the Listed winner Auditory (Noble Bijou), with this being the family of the New Zealand Champion Stayer and now sire Nom Du Jeu (Montjeu).

As a three-year-old he won the Secretariat Stakes (Gr 1, 10f) at Arlington Park before rounding out his campaign with success in the Hong Kong Vase (Gr 1, 2400m), while he secured his first victory as a four-year-old in the prestigious King George VI and Queen Elizabeth Stakes (Gr 1, 1m4f) at Ascot.

Further high profile victories followed in the Breeders' Cup Turf (Gr 1, 12f), Coronation Cup (Gr 1, 1m4f), Prince Of Wales's Stakes (Gr 1, 1m2f) before a winning swansong in the Hong Kong Vase in December. He amassed \$13,951,220 in total and retired as the highest-earning European horse in history.

Aidan O'Brien said of Highland Reel: "An incredible horse with pace and courage and tactical speed, he has everything."

Highland Reel also hails from a strong Australian family, being out of the Group One-placed, Australian-bred mare Hveger (Danehill), whose other runners include Highland Reel's brother, Idaho, a dual Group Two winner and placed in both the English and Irish Derbies (Gr 1, 1m4f).

His half-sister Valdemoro (Encosta De Lago) finished runner-up in both the VRC Oaks (Gr 1, 2500m) and Vinery Stud Stakes (Gr 1, 2000m), while this is also the family of Australian Group One winners Circles Of Gold (Marscay), Elvstroem (Danehill) and Haradasun (Fusaichi Pegasus).

"Swettenham Stud is extremely excited to have secured Highland Reel from Coolmore Stud for stallion duties in the southern hemisphere," Swettenham Stud principal Adam Sangster said.

"And while he might be standing at our Nagambie base, Highland Reel's appeal is truly global.

"With his tremendous race record and what is clearly a stallion's pedigree, I'm highly confident he will attract broodmare owners from all states, particularly at such a competitive fee."

Fastnet Rock was responsible for the two top lots at last week's Inglis Australian Easter Yearling Sale, with his 30 yearlings to sell during Book One achieving an aggregate of \$16,625,000 at an average of \$554,167.

Stakes double for Fastnet Rock

Fastnet Rock will again stand for a private fee at Coolmore Australia this year.

31 for I Am Invincible

The exciting Pure Elation (2 f ex Members Joy by Hussonet) took out the Percy Sykes Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m) at Randwick yesterday to provide Yarraman Park stallion I Am Invincible (Invincible Spirit) with his 31st stakes winner. The Peter and Paul Snowden-trained filly beat Fiesta by a length and a quarter in the \$600,000 sprint, giving I Am Invincible a Group Two quinella, with Outback Barbie (Spirit Of Boom) just a head further behind in third place. I Am Invincible was second leading sire by aggregate at the Inglis Australian Easter Yearling Sale, with his 34 yearlings selling for \$18,650,000.

"She could be the best filly we have trained," Snowden said. "Nothing went right in Melbourne. My call was to give her a break and bring her back later but Sir Owen said why not bring her back to Sydney and enjoy Sydney like she used to before. Her work has been great and she has responded well and I think she is an A-grade filly in the making."

The filly relished the step up to 1600 metres, beating Muswellbrook (Denman) by a long neck with Aristocratic Miss (Foxwedge) a further length behind in third. Sebring's progeny are headed by the Group One winners Dissident, Criterion, Egg Tart and Lucky Bubbles.

Champagne Stakes possible for Futooh

Co-trainer Ben Hayes said the talented Futooh, who fetched \$375,000 at last year's Inglis Australian Easter Yearling Sale, could back up in the ATC Champagne Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m) at Randwick on Saturday. "We've always had an opinion of her, and it's just nice to see her get out to a mile and running so well," Hayes said. "It's still a restricted race so you've got to keep a lid on it a little but I think she's a mare that could feature in some better races in Queensland over the carnival. I've no doubt she's up to Group level."

16 for Tavistock

Tavistock (Montjeu) was provided with his 16th stakes winner yesterday courtesy of Won Won Too's (3 g ex Celtic Dream by Casual Lies) victory in the Galilee Series Final (Listed, 2400m) at Caulfield. The lightly-raced three-year-old beat his stablemate Rezealient (Sebring) by a neck under jockey Jordan Childs in the \$150,000 feature, with the same distance back to Han Xin (Sepoy) in third place. Tavistock will stand for a private fee at Cambridge Stud this year.

Group Ones considered for Won Won Too

Following his victory in the Galilee Series Final, co-trainer Tom Dabernig said the gelding could be aimed at either the Queensland Derby (Gr 1, 2200m) or South Australian Derby (Gr 1, 2500m) in the coming weeks.
